6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; providing for a  
8 ten-year fishing, hunting, and combination  
9 hunting/fishing license; establishing the fee for the  
10 ten-year licenses; making license holders subject to  
11 certain restrictions and regulations; making ten-year  
12 hunting license in lieu of all other licenses and  
13 permits; establishing fee for issuance of duplicate  
14 license; requiring purchase of a ten-year Oklahoma  
15 Wildlife Land Stamp; establishing ten-year Oklahoma  
16 Wildlife Land Stamp fee; providing for distribution  
17 of the stamp fee; authorizing the Oklahoma Wildlife  
18 Conservation Commission to provide for issuance of  
19 the stamp; requiring termination of the stamp and  
20 stamp fee upon completion of certain conditions;  
21 providing for codification; and providing an  
22 effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-113.1 of Title 29, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. All legal residents who have resided in the state for at  
23 least six (6) months may purchase ten-year fishing licenses, ten-  
24

1 year hunting licenses or ten-year combination hunting/fishing  
2 licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation Director.

3 B. The fee for these licenses shall be:

- 4 1. Ten-year fishing license, One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00);
- 5 2. Ten-year hunting license, Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00);

6 and

- 7 3. Ten-year combination hunting/fishing license, Three Hundred  
8 Seventy-five Dollars (\$375.00).

9 C. The use of the licenses provided in this section is subject  
10 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the  
11 Wildlife Conservation Commission. Except as otherwise provided for  
12 in this section, the ten-year hunting license shall be in lieu of  
13 all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

14 D. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a  
15 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation  
16 for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

17 E. A ten-year licensee shall not lose the privileges of such  
18 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

19 F. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsection B  
20 of this section, a person purchasing a ten-year fishing, hunting or  
21 combination license shall be required to purchase a ten-year  
22 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. Each person shall have the stamp in  
23 their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any wildlife.  
24 The fee for the ten-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp shall be

1 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00). The fee for the stamp shall be  
2 distributed as follows:

3 a. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) from each stamp shall be  
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created  
5 in Section 4-141 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
6 to be used to retire the obligations and related  
7 expenses as authorized pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
8 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes or to purchase,  
9 lease, or purchase easements on real property to be  
10 used as public hunting, fishing, and trapping areas,  
11 and

12 b. Three Dollars (\$3.00) from each stamp shall be  
13 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created  
14 in Section 4-141 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
15 to be used by the Commission for management of the  
16 real property acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
17 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with  
18 proceeds from the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

19 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall  
20 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the  
21 ten-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

22 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or  
23 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
24 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the ten-year Oklahoma Wildlife

1 Land Stamp and ten-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee  
2 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2009.
