6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; modifying
8 general powers of municipalities; requiring
9 certification training for certain municipal
employees; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 111.1 of Title 11, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Employees of a municipality employed or otherwise assigned to
17 enforce provisions of Section 22-111 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
18 Statutes shall complete certification training specifically
19 applicable to such section as adopted and administered by the
20 Oklahoma Code Enforcement Association, an internationally recognized
21 model code organization, career technical education program, or an
22 institution of higher education. The certification training shall
23 be completed within one (1) year of employment or assignment for
24 such enforcement.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 112.2 of Title 11, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 Employees of a municipality assigned to enforce provisions of
5 Sections 22-112 and 22-112.1 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes
6 shall complete certification training specifically applicable to
7 such section as adopted and administered by the Oklahoma Code
8 Enforcement Association, an internationally recognized model code
9 organization, career technical education program, or an institution
10 of higher education. The certification training shall be completed
11 within one (1) year of employment or assignment for such
12 enforcement.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
