6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
8 directing the Legislative Service Bureau to contract
9 for certain audit; specifying areas of focus for the
10 audit; requiring a final report to be submitted to
11 the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
12 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the
13 Senate; providing for noncodification; providing an
14 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 A. The Legislative Service Bureau shall contract for an
19 independent performance audit of the Department of Human Services.
20 The audit shall be a comprehensive review of the agency's operations
21 and shall include, but not be limited to, a primary focus on:

- 22 1. Improving efficiency in management and structure;
- 23 2. Eliminating barriers in communications;
- 24 3. Reducing employee turnover;
4. Determining optimal training programs; and

1 5. Improving outcomes for individuals and families served by
2 the agency.

3 B. Upon completion of the audit, a final report with
4 recommendations shall be submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of
5 the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore
6 of the State Senate.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
