6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to courts; amending 20 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 1304A, which relates to publication of court
9 dockets in certain counties; clarifying language; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2001, Section 1304A, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1304A. In each county with a population of more than
16 two hundred thousand (200,000) according to the latest Federal
17 Decennial Census, the chief judge of the district court may, with
18 the concurrence of the majority of the district judges regularly
19 serving in the county, authorize the publication of court dockets in
20 a daily newspaper designated by order of such judges, which
21 newspaper is qualified by law to publish legal notices. The cost of
22 ~~such~~ the service shall be paid for by the court clerk out of the
23 court fund on a monthly basis. It shall be computed by multiplying
24 the number of all civil cases filed during the preceding month, ~~save~~

1 ~~and except~~ with the exception of small claims suits and juvenile,
2 mental health, habeas corpus and paternity proceedings, by the sum
3 of Three Dollars (\$3.00). The amount ~~se~~ computed shall be paid to
4 the designated newspaper publisher upon a verified claim presented
5 to the court clerk. The newspaper designated under the provisions
6 of this act shall publish daily a docket that shall include jury,
7 nonjury, motion and demurrer, criminal and civil dockets as well as
8 all ~~such~~ other proceedings of the district court sitting in the
9 county as the chief judge, with a concurrence of the majority of the
10 district judges regularly serving in the county, may order.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
