7 An Act relating to public health and safety; limiting
8 dispensation of certain product; providing procedure
9 prior to sale of certain product; making certain acts
unlawful; providing penalties; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-611 of Title 63, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any
17 detectable quantity of dextromethorphan shall be dispensed, sold, or
18 distributed only by, or under the supervision of, a licensed
19 pharmacist or a registered pharmacy technician.

20 B. Any person purchasing, receiving, or otherwise acquiring any
21 compound, mixture, or preparation containing any detectable quantity
22 of dextromethorphan shall produce a valid driver license or other
23 state-issued identification card showing the date of birth of the
24 person.

1 C. It shall be unlawful for any person to dispense, sell, or
2 distribute any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any
3 detectable quantity of dextromethorphan to a person who is under
4 eighteen (18) years of age. Any person convicted of violating the
5 provisions of this section shall be guilty of misdemeanor,
6 punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one
7 (1) year, or by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars
8 (\$500.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
