6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
8 General; making appropriation; stating purpose of
9 appropriation; providing an effective date; and
10 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
14 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand
17 Dollars (\$750,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to
18 develop and implement an Immigration Enforcement Program within the
19 Office of the Attorney General for the primary purpose of awarding
20 and distributing funds to local law enforcement agencies charged
21 with enforcing the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 1804 of the
22 1st Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature. The Office of the
23 Attorney General shall develop an application process and publish
24 the criteria it shall use for awarding and distributing the funds.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
