6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; stating  
8 Legislative intent that the Oklahoma State Regents  
9 for Higher Education adopt a certain policy on  
10 residency for dependents of certain United States  
11 Department of State employees; providing for  
12 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State  
17 Regents for Higher Education review its state residency policies for  
18 tuition and fees, scholarship, and financial aid purposes and adopt  
19 a policy that allows the dependents of employees of the United  
20 States Department of State who are stationed outside the United  
21 States but have retained Oklahoma residency to be charged resident  
22 tuition and have the opportunity to participate in all state  
23 scholarship and financial aid programs as residents.

1       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
