6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending Section 12,
8 Chapter 432, O.S.L. 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section
9 509.11), which relates to statewide professional
10 educators' association access to school employees;
11 deleting certain types of access; prohibiting
12 employee associations or organizations from utilizing
13 school services and equipment; providing an effective
14 date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 432, O.S.L.
17 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 509.11), is amended to read as
18 follows:

19 Section 509.11 A. No school district, employee of a school
20 district, or employee organization shall deny by any means,
21 including a collective bargaining agreement, a statewide
22 professional educators' association equal access to employees of the
23 school district, to the same extent that access is granted to other
24 educators' associations. For purposes of this section, access shall
include, but is not limited to:

- 1 1. Setting up informational tables at in-service or other
- 2 similar teacher meetings;
- 3 2. Speaking at in-service or other similar teacher meetings;
- 4 3. ~~Distributing information in school mail boxes or through the~~
- 5 ~~school e-mail system;~~
- 6 4. Utilizing school district meeting rooms during nonworking
- 7 hours; and
- 8 5. 4. Representing employees in employment matters, when
- 9 requested by the employee;
- 10 6. ~~Posting information on school district bulletin boards; and~~
- 11 7. ~~Utilizing school district printing services.~~

12 B. Any association which utilizes school district facilities ~~or~~

13 ~~services~~ shall reimburse the district for any costs incurred by the

14 district. No employee association or employee organization shall be

15 allowed to utilize school district services or equipment.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation

18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
