6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring foreign  
8 drivers to obtain certain permit; authorizing  
9 Department of Public Safety to assess reasonable fee  
10 for issuance of certain permit; directing Department  
11 of Public Safety to collaborate and coordinate with  
12 certain entities; providing for promulgation and  
13 adoption of rules; providing for codification; and  
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-602.2 of Title 47, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Every foreign driver who is operating a motor vehicle in  
20 this state pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-102 of Title 47  
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be required to obtain a mobility  
22 permit from the Department of Public Safety on an annual basis. A  
23 mobility permit issued to a foreign driver shall be accepted as  
24 proof that the foreign driver has complied with the compulsory motor

1 vehicle liability insurance and financial responsibility laws of  
2 this state.

3 B. The Department of Public Safety shall assess a reasonable  
4 fee for the issuance of mobility permits. Such fee shall be  
5 deposited in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

6 C. The Department of Public Safety shall coordinate and  
7 collaborate with foreign embassies and consular offices when  
8 developing the mobility permit program.

9 D. The Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby authorized to  
10 promulgate and adopt rules as may be necessary to implement the  
11 provisions of this act.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
