6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; amending
8 Section 1, Chapter 312, O.S.L. 2006, as amended by
9 Section 2, Chapter 365, O.S.L. 2007 (37 O.S. Supp.
10 2007, Section 8.2), which relates to the consumption
11 of alcohol by minors; clarifying language; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 312, O.S.L.
15 2006, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 365, O.S.L. 2007 (37 O.S.
16 Supp. 2007, Section 8.2), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 8.2 A. No person shall knowingly and willfully permit
18 any individual under twenty-one (21) years of age who is an invitee
19 to the ~~person's~~ residence of the person, any building, structure, or
20 room owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person or
21 on any land owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the
22 person, to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage as defined by
23 Section 506 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any controlled
24 dangerous substance as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous
Substances Act, or any combination thereof, in such place.

1 B. Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause
2 great bodily injury or the death of a person, shall, in addition to
3 any other penalty provided by law, be guilty of a felony, punishable
4 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for
5 not more than five (5) years, a fine of not less than Two Thousand
6 Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars
7 (\$5,000.00), or both such fine and imprisonment.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
