6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; providing for
8 equal compensation to employees of the Oklahoma House
9 of Representatives; providing basis for comparison of
10 compensation; providing for codification; providing
11 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 456.25 of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Effective July 1, 2008, the compensation and all benefits
17 paid to employees of the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall be
18 equal to the compensation and all benefits paid to the employees of
19 the Oklahoma State Senate for work performed in substantially
20 equivalent jobs.

21 B. The provisions of this section shall be applicable to the
22 Chief Clerk of the House, employees of the Chief Clerk, the
23 Committee Staff employees, the employees of the Office of Budget and
24 Performance Review, the Engrossing and Enrolling department, House

1 Bill Processing department, Data Processing department and all other
2 personnel employed by the Oklahoma House of Representatives not
3 specifically described by this subsection.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
