6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to juvenile facility funding; stating
8 legislative intent; creating Local Juvenile Facility
9 Support Revolving Fund; providing for deposit of
10 monies; authorizing certain expenditures; stating
11 legislative intent with respect to appropriations to
12 Department of Human Services; stating legislative
13 intent with respect to appropriation for certain
14 audit; providing for codification; providing for
15 noncodification; providing an effective date; and
16 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20 It is the intent of the Legislature to provide funding from
21 existing budgetary resources for the development and implementation
22 of a pilot program to provide funding for counties and other
23 regional entities to establish locally funded and operated
24 multipurpose juvenile facilities.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-6.15 of Title 56, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
5 for the Department of Human Services to be designated the "Local
6 Juvenile Facility Support Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
7 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
8 consist of all monies received by the Department of Human Services
9 from the appropriations savings referred to in Section 2 of this
10 act. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
11 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of
12 Human Services for the purpose of establishing regional juvenile
13 facilities. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants
14 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
15 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 It is the intent of the Legislature to reduce the appropriation
19 level of the state appropriation component of the Department of
20 Human Services budget by one percentage point each fiscal year
21 beginning with the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2009, for a period
22 of five (5) fiscal years. The revenues that would otherwise have
23 been appropriated to the Department of Human Services achieved
24 through the reduction referred to in this section shall be deposited

1 into the Local Juvenile Facility Support Revolving Fund created
2 pursuant to Section 2 of this act.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate for the
6 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, such funds as may be required for
7 the performance of an audit of the Office of Juvenile Affairs with
8 special emphasis on monies expended for youth services programs.

9 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

10 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
