6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; directing
8 institutions within The Oklahoma State System for
9 Higher Education to develop and implement an
10 entrepreneurship class; requiring all students to
11 take the class prior to degree completion; stating
12 purpose of the class; allowing institutions to offer
13 the entrepreneurship class on an accessible Internet
14 website; providing for codification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3246 of Title 70, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Each institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
21 Education is hereby directed to develop and implement an
22 entrepreneurship class in which, beginning with the 2009-2010 school
23 year, all students enrolled in the institution shall be required to
24 take prior to degree completion. The purpose of the
25 entrepreneurship class is to expose all students, in all majors, to
26 basic entrepreneurial concepts, core knowledge and skills which

1 include, but are not limited to, the ability to recognize
2 opportunities in life, pursue opportunities by generating new ideas
3 and marshaling needed resources, create and operate a new venture,
4 and to think in a creative and critical manner.

5 B. An institution may develop and offer the entrepreneurship
6 class as an on-line class which would be available on an Internet
7 website that is accessible to all students.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
