5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to cities and towns; stating
7 legislative findings; providing for expenditures to
8 certain persons for energy conservation activities;
9 providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35-206 of Title 11, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Oklahoma State Legislature hereby determines that
16 expenditures of funds for the purposes of the conservation of
17 electricity or natural gas by public agencies is in the public
18 interest. In furtherance of this public interest, municipally owned
19 utilities or public trusts thereof or the Grand River Dam Authority
20 may expend, with governing board approval, funds to assist consumers
21 in the establishment of energy conservation activities if there is a
22 defined and measurable conservation of energy. The expenditures may
23 be made subsequent to achievement of measures outlined in an energy
24 audit or an engineering audit of the consumer's operations.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
