7 An Act relating to energy; amending 17 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 157, which relates to an assessment of
9 electrical power and energy needs of the state;
clarifying statutory language; and providing an
effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2001, Section 157, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 157. A. The Commission shall prepare a ten-year
16 assessment of the electrical power and energy requirements of this
17 state and assess the need for additional or replacement generating
18 facilities and the associated costs of ~~such~~ the facilities to the
19 electric consumers of this state. The Commission shall reassess the
20 statewide future electrical generation requirements every two (2)
21 years. ~~Such~~ The assessments shall not constitute official
22 Commission certification or approval of any proposed generating
23 facilities.

1 B. For the purposes of this section, every public utility and
2 generation and transmission association or cooperative corporation,
3 the Grand River Dam Authority, the Oklahoma Municipal Power
4 Authority, and any municipality proposing to construct generating
5 facilities shall submit to the Commission, for the purpose of
6 review, a list of all proposed projects for the construction,
7 alteration or modification designed to increase electrical
8 generating capacity of any electricity-production facility located
9 within the state, along with any supporting data the Commission
10 might direct.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
