6 AS INTRODUCED

7
8 An Act directing the Secretary of State to refer to
9 the people for their approval or rejection a proposed
10 amendment to Section 1 of Article VI of the
11 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, which relates
12 to the Executive Department; clarifying language;
13 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18 the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article VI of the
19 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

20 Section 1. A. The Executive authority of the state shall be
21 vested in a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State
22 Auditor and Inspector, Attorney General, State Treasurer,
23 Superintendent of Public Instruction, Commissioner of Labor,
24 Commissioner of Insurance and other officers provided by law and
this Constitution, each of whom shall keep ~~his office~~ the

1 administrative center and public records, books and papers
2 pertaining to the office at the seat of government, and shall
3 perform such duties as may be designated in this Constitution or
4 prescribed by law.

5 B. The Secretary of State shall be appointed by the Governor by
6 and with the consent of the Senate for a term of four (4) years to
7 run concurrently with the term of the Governor.

8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
10 the following form:

12 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It clarifies a
15 provision of the Constitution. It is the section that lists
16 state officers. These are officers in the Executive Department
17 of state government.

21 SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
22 immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and

2 Attorney General.
