7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Joint Resolution approving permanent rules of the
9 Oklahoma State Board of Career and Technology
10 Education; directing distribution; and declaring an
11 emergency.

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate
14 the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, approve, delay,
15 suspend, veto, or amend the implementation of any rule or proposed
16 rule while under review by the Legislature, determine that a rule is
17 not consistent with legislative intent, and suspend any rule or any
18 portion thereof at any time; and

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 14-104 and 14-108 of Title 70 of
20 the Oklahoma Statutes, the State Board of Career and Technology
21 Education shall be responsible for promulgating and adopting rules
22 as necessary and appropriate for the administration and operation of
23 the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, as well

1 as to prescribe criteria and procedures for the establishment and
2 governance of technology center school districts; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that proposed permanent
4 rules OAC 780:1-13-1, OAC 780:10-3-2, OAC 780:10-3-3, OAC 780:10-3-
5 11, OAC 780:10-3-12, OAC 780:10-9-1, OAC 780:15-3-1, OAC 780:15-3-2,
6 OAC 780:15-3-4, OAC 780:15-3-6, OAC 780:15-3-7, OAC 780:15-3-8, OAC
7 780:20-1-1, OAC 780:20-1-2, OAC 780:20-3-1 and OAC 780:20-3-2, which
8 were adopted by the State Board of Career and Technology Education
9 on March 27, 2008, and submitted for consideration to the Governor
10 and the Legislature on April 2, 2008, are consistent with
11 legislative intent and the public policy of this state.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

14 SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby approves proposed permanent
15 rules OAC 780:1-13-1, OAC 780:10-3-2, OAC 780:10-3-3, OAC 780:10-3-
16 11, OAC 780:10-3-12, OAC 780:10-9-1, OAC 780:15-3-1, OAC 780:15-3-2,
17 OAC 780:15-3-4, OAC 780:15-3-6, OAC 780:15-3-7, OAC 780:15-3-8, OAC
18 780:20-1-1, OAC 780:20-1-2, OAC 780:20-3-1 and OAC 780:20-3-2.

19 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
20 distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Director
21 of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, and
22 the editor of "The Oklahoma Register."

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
