6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution condemning the U.S. House of  
8 Representatives leadership for their plan to relocate  
9 terrorists to Fort Sill, Oklahoma, or anywhere else  
10 in the continental United States; and directing  
11 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the U.S. House of Representatives leadership unveiled a  
13 plan to close the Guantanamo Bay detention facility in Cuba and  
14 import dangerous terrorists into American communities; and

15 WHEREAS, options for moving these terrorists to detention  
16 facilities based in the continental United States included Fort  
17 Sill, Oklahoma, as a potential relocation point; and

18 WHEREAS, the terrorists housed at Guantanamo Bay are considered  
19 some of the most dangerous people in the world, and they continue to  
20 pose a clear threat to the safety of the United States and its  
21 citizens; and

22 WHEREAS, transferring these terrorists to Fort Sill could make  
23 the area a more likely target for terrorist attack, ultimately  
24 putting the lives of all Oklahomans in extreme danger.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives condemns the U.S.  
4 House of Representatives leadership for their plan to relocate  
5 terrorists to Fort Sill, Oklahoma, or anywhere else in the  
6 continental United States.

7 THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to all members of  
8 the Oklahoma congressional delegation.
