7 A Resolution congratulating the StableRidge Winery;
8 expressing appreciation; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the wine industry continues to grow in Oklahoma with 47
12 wineries currently operating in the state; and

13 WHEREAS, Oklahoma wineries have received a great deal of
14 positive recognition in competitions on the local, regional,
15 national, and international levels; and

16 WHEREAS, one of these competitions, the Finger Lakes
17 International Wine Competition, is open to commercially produced
18 wines from anywhere in the world; and

19 WHEREAS, 377 wineries from around the world submitted 2,108
20 wines into the competition; and

21 WHEREAS, competition results were announced on April 7, 2007,
22 with awards for four levels of excellence: double gold, gold,
23 silver, and bronze; and

1 WHEREAS, only seven wineries won multiple gold medals, including
2 StableRidge Winery in Stroud, Oklahoma; and

3 WHEREAS, StableRidge Winery received a gold medal for its Chenin
4 Blanc and a gold medal for its Jeremiah's Red.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
6 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

7 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives congratulates the
8 StableRidge Winery in Stroud, Oklahoma, for its great success in the
9 Finger Lakes International Wine Competition, and expresses sincere
10 appreciation for its stellar representation of Oklahoma wineries.
