11 2005, brought to national attention the heartbreaking reality of
12 child abuse in our country and its tragic consequences; and

13 WHEREAS, Kelsey's story has inspired many in the crusade to
14 prevent child abuse; and

15 WHEREAS, the first annual Kelsey Briggs Day was held on April
16 29, 2006, in honor of Kelsey's memory and to raise awareness of
17 child abuse prevention; and

18 WHEREAS, the purpose of Kelsey Briggs Day is to share Kelsey's
19 story and distribute child abuse prevention information, including
20 materials about hotlines, shelters, and local agencies that can
21 help, and how to recognize signs of abuse; and

22 WHEREAS, the third annual Kelsey Briggs Day will be held on
23 April 26, 2008.
