9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Educational  
11 Television Authority; making an appropriation;  
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain  
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance  
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of  
15 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing  
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
20 Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise  
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
24 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television  
Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
2 Oklahoma Educational Television Authority shall budget all funds in  
3 the following categories and amounts:

8 The Authority shall develop outcome-based performance measures  
9 for each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
12 upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be  
13 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed  
14 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for  
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Educational  
16 Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall  
17 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
18 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
19 capitol and special projects except as may be authorized pursuant to  
20 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
