9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Commissioners of the Land
11 Office; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Secretary and the Assistant
16 Secretary; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commissioners of
20 the Land Office from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
2 Commissioners of the Land Office shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

10 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures
11 for each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Department of the Commissioners of the Land Office by law
15 shall be set by the Secretary of the Department. The salary of the
16 Secretary shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
17 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
18 The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety
19 percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly
20 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Department of the
21 Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30,
22 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
23 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
24 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be

1 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
2 the Oklahoma Statutes:
