9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
11 Libraries; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
16 limitations; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
19 Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
20 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
21 year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
22 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
23 upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
2 Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the  
3 following categories and amounts:

9 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures  
10 for each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
13 upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the  
14 Director of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries. The salary of the  
15 Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
16 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.  
17 The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June  
18 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
19 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
20 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
21 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
22 the Oklahoma Statutes:
