9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Physician Manpower Training
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician
20 Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission
by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
2 Physician Manpower Training Commission shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set
18 by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The salary of the
19 Executive Director shall not exceed _____Dollars (\$0.00)
20 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
21 The Physician Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
23 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
24 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as

1 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
2 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
