AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Physician Manpower Training Commission; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Physician Manpower Training Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set
10 by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The salary of the
11 Executive Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
12 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
13 The Physician Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
15 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
16 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
17 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
18 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
