9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Ethics Commission; requiring
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
12 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
13 duties and compensation of employees; providing
14 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
15 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Ethics
18 Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and
19 amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Ethics Commission by law shall be set by the Executive
6 Director. The Ethics Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
7 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
8 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
9 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
10 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
11 the Oklahoma Statutes:
