9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tax Commission;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
18 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall budget all funds in the following  
19 categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Oklahoma Tax Commission by law shall be set by the Oklahoma  
12 Tax Commission. The Oklahoma Tax Commission for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
14 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
15 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
16 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
17 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
