9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing budgetary limitations; providing for duties
14 and compensation of employees; limiting salary of
15 Commissioner; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
18 Department of Health shall budget all funds in the following
19 categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the State Department of Health by law shall be set by the State
11 Commissioner of Health. The salary of the Commissioner shall not
12 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The State Department of Health
14 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
15 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
16 and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special
17 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
