AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Administrator; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the  
11 Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The salary of  
12 the Administrator shall not exceed \_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,  
13 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The  
14 Oklahoma Health Care Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
15 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations,  
16 except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section  
17 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
