10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the University Hospitals
12 Authority; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
13 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
14 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
15 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the University
20 Hospitals Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the University Hospitals Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
2 University Hospitals Authority shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

Hospital Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the
11 University Hospitals Authority. The University Hospitals Authority
12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
13 following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized
14 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
15 Oklahoma Statutes:
