10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
12 Veterans Affairs; making an appropriation; stating  
13 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
14 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
15 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
16 limiting the salary of the Director; providing  
17 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
18 date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
21 Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise  
22 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
24 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform

1 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs  
2 by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
4 Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in  
5 the following categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
13 each budget category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
16 upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set  
17 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
18 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June  
19 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following  
21 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as  
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
