AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of
Rehabilitation Services; requiring budgeting in
certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
performance measures; providing for exemptions from
certain expenditure limitations; providing for duties
and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of
the Director; providing budgetary limitation; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
Department of Rehabilitation Services shall budget all appropriated
and other funds in the following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 Receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded
6 the State Department of Rehabilitation Services after July 1, 2008,
7 shall be exempt from expenditure limitations, provided that any such
8 funds used for operations shall be included in the agency's budget
9 work program.

10 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the State Department of Rehabilitation Services by law shall be
13 set by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services. The salary of
14 the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
15 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
16 The State Department of Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
18 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
19 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
20 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
21 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
