10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and  
12 Centennial Commemoration Commission; making an  
13 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting  
14 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain  
15 performance measures; providing for duties and  
16 compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the  
17 Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations;  
18 and providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Capitol  
21 Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission from any monies not  
22 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State  
23 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of  
24 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary

1 to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and  
2 Centennial Commemoration Commission by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
4 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission  
5 shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

6 <u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
7 General Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
9 the budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
12 upon the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration  
13 Commission by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and  
14 Centennial Commemoration Commission. The salary of the Executive  
15 Director shall be set by the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
16 Commemoration Commission and shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
17 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June  
18 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration  
19 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be  
20 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
21 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
22 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
23 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
24 Statutes:

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.
