9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Insurance Department; making
11 an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Insurance
19 Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the Insurance Department by law.

24 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
Insurance Department shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Insurance Department by law shall be set by the Insurance
11 Commissioner. The Insurance Department, for the fiscal year ending
12 June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
13 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
14 excluding expenditures on capital and special projects, except as
15 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
16 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
