9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the J.M. Davis Memorial
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Executive Director;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.M. Davis
20 Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
23 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the J.M.
Davis Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 the budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the
8 J.M. Davis Memorial Commission. The salary of the Executive
9 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
10 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 The J.M.
11 Davis Memorial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009
12 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
13 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
14 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
15 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
16 Oklahoma Statutes:
