10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Scenic Rivers Commission;  
12 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
13 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
14 requiring certain performance measures; providing for  
duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary  
of Administrator; providing budgetary limitations;  
and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Scenic Rivers  
19 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
21 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so  
22 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon  
23 the Scenic Rivers Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Scenic  
2 Rivers Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories  
3 and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Scenic Rivers Commission by law shall be set by the  
11 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission. The salary of the  
12 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission shall not exceed  
13 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Scenic Rivers Commission, for  
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the  
16 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
17 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
18 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
19 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
