AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
Recreation Department; requiring budgeting in certain
categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
measures; providing for duties and compensation of
employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department shall budget all funds in
the following categories and amounts:

22 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law shall be

1 set by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. The salary
2 of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
3 annum payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The
4 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for the fiscal year
5 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
6 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
7 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
8 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
9 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
