9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting the salary of the Director; authorizing
15 employment of certain percentage of employees in the
16 unclassified service; providing budgetary
17 limitations; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
20 Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the
14 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
15 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2009. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2009, shall be authorized to employ up to six
18 percent (6%) of its total authorized full-time-equivalent employees
19 in the unclassified service and shall be subject to the following
20 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
21 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
22 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
23 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
