9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the district courts; authorizing  
11 an expenditure by the Supreme Court for the district  
12 courts; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in  
13 certain categories and amounts; limiting salaries of  
certain employees; providing budgetary limitations;  
and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. The Supreme Court is hereby authorized to expend  
18 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, from the State Judicial  
19 Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
20 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the  
21 financial support of the district courts.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
23 Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made

1 available for the operation of the district courts in the following  
 2 categories and amounts:

5 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the annual  
 6 compensation of the following employees of the district courts  
 7 payable monthly from appropriated funds shall not exceed the  
 8 following schedule, exclusive of overtime and longevity payments,  
 9 except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section  
 10 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

15 SECTION 4. The district courts, for the fiscal year ending June  
 16 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
 17 full-time-equivalent employees excluding active retired judges, and  
 18 except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section  
 19 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
