9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the district courts; requiring
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts; limiting
12 salaries of certain employees; providing budgetary
13 limitations; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
16 Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made
17 available for the operation of the district courts in the following
18 categories and amounts:

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the annual
22 compensation of the following employees of the district courts
23 payable monthly from appropriated funds shall not exceed the
