11 AS INTRODUCED

12 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense  
13 System; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
14 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
15 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
16 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
17 providing budgetary limitations; exempting certain  
18 employees from budgetary limitations; and providing  
19 an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
22 Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
23 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
24 year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars

1 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
2 imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
4 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System shall budget all funds in the  
5 following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
15 upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law shall be set by the  
16 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System. The  
17 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
18 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
19 full-time-equivalent employees, except those used for the statewide  
20 Trial Indigent Defense System, and expenditures except as may be  
21 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
22 the Oklahoma Statutes:
