9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Investigation; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
13 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary
16 limitations; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
19 Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated
20 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
21 year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars
22 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
23 imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
2 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
15 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set
16 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
17 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma State Bureau of
19 Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
20 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
21 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
22 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
23 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes:
