10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Council on Judicial
12 Complaints; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
13 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
14 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
15 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
16 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary
17 limitations; and providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on
21 Judicial Complaints from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
22 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
23 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or

1 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
2 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
4 Council on Judicial Complaints shall budget all funds in the
5 following categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law shall be set by the
15 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
16 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Council on Judicial
18 Complaints for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
19 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
20 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
21 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
22 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes:
