9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
14 performance measures; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
16 Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
20 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not
21 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
22 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of
23 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
24 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State
Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
 2 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
 3 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
 9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 12 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
 13 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
 14 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
 15 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
 16 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
 17 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
 18 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
 19 except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding
 20 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
 21 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
 22 the Oklahoma Statutes:
