9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
19 Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
2 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

15 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
16 each budget category.

17 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
18 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the
20 Commissioner. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
22 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures,
23 except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include
24 cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their

1 employment in probationary status, excluding expenditures for
2 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
3 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes:
