10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Workers' Compensation Court;  
12 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
13 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers'  
19 Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
20 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
21 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
23 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
2 Workers' Compensation Court shall budget all funds in the following  
3 categories and amounts:

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law shall be set by the  
11 Administrator. The Workers' Compensation Court for the fiscal year  
12 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
13 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, excluding active  
14 retired judges, and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital  
15 and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
16 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

20 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.
