6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S.
8 2001, Section 4-114, as last amended by Section 16,
9 Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section
10 4-114), which relates to lifetime hunting and fishing
licenses; establishing fee for lifetime combination
11 hunting/fishing license for minors; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, as
15 last amended by Section 16, Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp.
16 2007, Section 4-114), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the
18 state for at least six (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing
19 licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime combination
20 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation
21 Director.

22 B. The fee for these licenses shall be:

- 23 1. Lifetime fishing license, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);
24 2. Lifetime hunting license, Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00);

1 3. Lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for persons
2 eighteen (18) years of age or older, Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars
3 (\$750.00);

4 4. Lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for persons
5 under eighteen (18) years of age, ten percent (10%) less than that
6 of persons under sixty (60) years of age;

7 5. Lifetime hunting license for persons sixty (60) years of age
8 or older, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);

9 ~~5.~~ 6. Lifetime fishing license for persons sixty (60) years of
10 age or older, Thirty Dollars (\$30.00); and

11 ~~6.~~ 7. Lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for persons
12 sixty (60) years of age or older, Two Hundred Fifteen Dollars
13 (\$215.00).

14 C. Legal resident having proper certification from the United
15 States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor certifying
16 that the person is a disabled veteran may purchase a disability
17 lifetime combination hunting/fishing license from the State Wildlife
18 Conservation Director. The fees for the license shall be as
19 follows:

20 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for veterans having a
21 disability of less than sixty percent (60%); and

22 2. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for veterans having a
23 disability of sixty percent (60%) or more.

1 D. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject
2 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the
3 Wildlife Conservation Commission. Except as otherwise provided for
4 in this section, the lifetime hunting license shall be in lieu of
5 all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

6 E. Nonresidents may purchase a lifetime nonresident fishing
7 license. The fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty
8 Dollars (\$250.00).

9 F. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a
10 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation
11 for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

12 G. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such
13 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

14 H. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsections
15 B, C and E of this section, a person purchasing a lifetime fishing,
16 hunting or combination license shall be required to purchase a
17 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. Each person shall have the
18 stamp in ~~their~~ his or her possession while hunting, fishing, or
19 taking any wildlife. The fee for the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife
20 Land Stamp shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). The fee for the
21 stamp shall be distributed as follows:

22 a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) from each stamp shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
24 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used to retire

1 the obligations and related expenses as authorized
2 pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes or to purchase, lease, or purchase easements
4 on real property to be used as public hunting,
5 fishing, and trapping areas; and

6 b. Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each stamp shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
8 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used by the
9 Commission for management of the real property
10 acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the
11 Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the
12 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

13 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall
14 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the
15 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

16 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or
17 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of
18 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife
19 Land Stamp and Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee
20 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
