6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public safety; requiring state
8 agencies to withdraw certain membership; prohibiting
9 state agencies from reestablishing certain
10 membership; prohibiting state agencies from
11 establishing certain membership; directing the
12 Department of Public Safety to retrieve and secure
13 certain information; authorizing the Department to
14 directly share certain information with agencies of
15 other state, federal, or foreign governments;
16 providing for codification; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-110.4 of Title 47, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Any agency or department of the state, or a political
23 subdivision thereof, which, as of the effective date of this act,
24 holds a membership with the American Association of Motor Vehicle
Administrators or any other organization that establishes national
or international standards for the design, issuance, or renewal of
driver licenses or identification cards, or the collection, storage,

1 or exchange of information associated with such documents, is hereby
2 directed to withdraw such membership, and is prohibited from
3 reestablishing such membership at any future time. Any agency or
4 department of the state, or a political subdivision thereof, which,
5 as of the effective date of this act, does not hold such a
6 membership is prohibited from establishing such a membership at any
7 future time.

8 B. Any information regarding the design, issuance, or renewal
9 of driver licenses or identification cards in this state, or the
10 collection, storage, or exchange of information associated with such
11 documents, which has been provided by any department or agency of
12 this state, or a political subdivision thereof, to the American
13 Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators or any other
14 organization that establishes national or international standards
15 for the design, issuance, or renewal of driver licenses or
16 identification cards, or the collection, storage, or exchange of
17 information associated with such documents, shall be retrieved and
18 secured by the Department of Public Safety.

19 C. The Department of Public Safety may directly share
20 information regarding the design, issuance, or renewal of driver
21 licenses or identification cards in this state, or the collection,
22 storage, or exchange of information associated with such documents
23 with departments and agencies of other states, the federal

1 government, or the governments of foreign countries as provided in
2 Section 6-102 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
