6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; prohibiting  
8 computer-assisted remote hunting of animals and  
9 birds; providing penalties; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 201.1 of Title 29, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. No person shall operate, provide, sell, or use or offer to  
16 operate, provide, sell, or use any computer software or service that  
17 allows a person, not physically present, to remotely control a  
18 firearm or weapon to hunt any live animal or bird.

19 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this  
20 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a  
21 fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), imprisonment in  
22 the county jail not exceeding one (1) year, or both such fine and  
23 imprisonment. In addition to the penalty, the court shall revoke  
24 hunting licenses, if any, of the person convicted of the violation

1 of this section and prohibit any issuance of any hunting license to  
2 that person for a period of not less than three (3) or more than  
3 five (5) years. The cost of reinstatement of the hunting license  
4 shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for legal residents and Five  
5 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for nonresidents. The reinstatement fee  
6 shall be in addition to the fees required for the hunting license.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
