7 An Act relating to state employees; amending 74 O.S.
8 2001, Section 7010, as amended by Section 19, Chapter
9 312, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 7010),
10 which relates to the Oklahoma State Employee
11 Charitable Contribution Act; adding certain services
12 for certain persons; stating certain requirement for
13 boards of directors; exempting Local Independent
14 Charities of America and certain participating
15 federations from certain eligibility requirements;
16 and providing an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 7010, as
amended by Section 19, Chapter 312, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2007,
Section 7010), is amended to read as follows:

Section 7010. A. A charitable agency wishing to be admitted to
the State Charitable Campaign shall be required to demonstrate state
presence. The agency must comply with all of the following criteria
in order to meet the state presence test:

1. The agency must provide or procure direct or indirect human
care services for persons residing in the state in which the
charitable contribution campaign will be conducted;

1 2. The agency shall have a board of directors ~~that,~~ the
2 majority of which serves without compensation;

3 3. A majority of the members of the board of directors shall be
4 residents of the state;

5 4. Consumers of service from the state shall be represented
6 within the membership of the board of directors; and

7 5. A substantial portion of the agency's annual budget shall be
8 derived from public solicitations in the State of Oklahoma.

9 B. Agencies whose primary focus is the providing of services to
10 the needy overseas ~~and,~~ the Combined Health Agencies operating in
11 this state, Local Independent Charities of America, and all
12 participating federations shall be exempt from complying with the
13 criteria set out in subsection A of this section and need not
14 demonstrate state presence.

15 C. The Armed Forces Veterans Homes Foundation shall be exempt
16 from the provisions of this section and shall be authorized to
17 participate in the State Charitable Campaign.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
